Guideline - All Emergency Response Calls

1. Respond only to calls that apply to you.
Example: EMS Assist calls - only First Responders
Example: Rehab - must ride in Rehab Unit
2. Begin your response at radio dispatch.
3. After page is received, radio your response.
Example: "75XX responding structure fire 222 Smith Road"
Do not call dispatch to report your response.
4. Do not call dispatch or other department members on Channel 72 to ask for directions to the scene. Use your street list and map pages.
5. Obey all traffic rules enroute to the scene.
6. If you receive an "All units not on scene cancel" or "Signal 9" page, do not continue to the scene.
7. Park your POV well away from the scene to allow access to other emergency vehicles and permit a clear flow of traffic.
8. Drop a cone or station someone on the main road to direct later responders to the site of a difficult-to-locate scene.
9. Upon arrival at the scene, turn your radio to channel 73.
10. Dress in full gear as appropriate to the type of call.
11. Tag out at the On Scene Board.
12. Report to Incident Command at the apparatus for assignment.
13. Do not enter the 20 foot action circle without an assignment.
14. Do not smoke near an MVA.
15. Report to Incident Command before removing your tag out card and leaving the scene.
